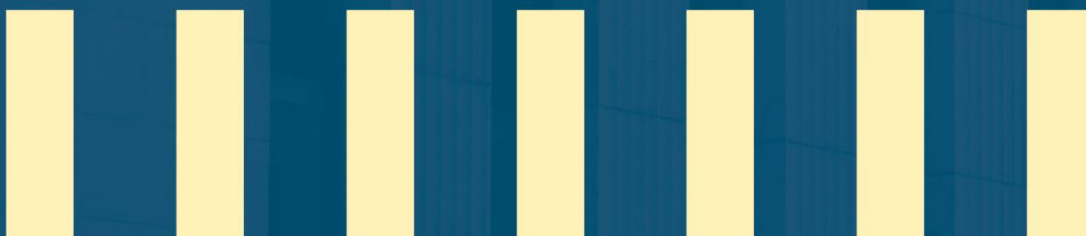

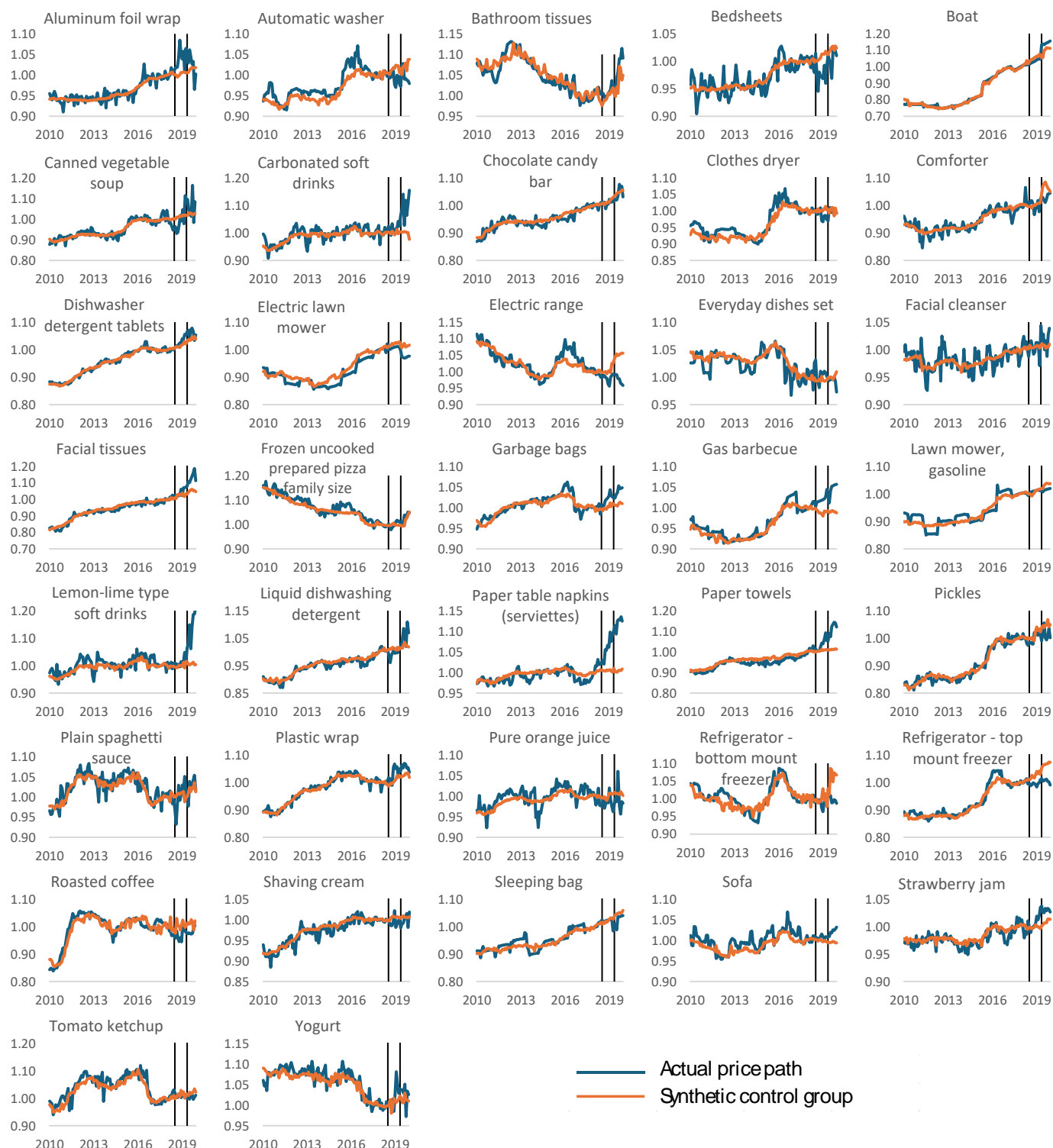

Chart B-1: Impact of 2018 tariffs on consumer prices, by representative product

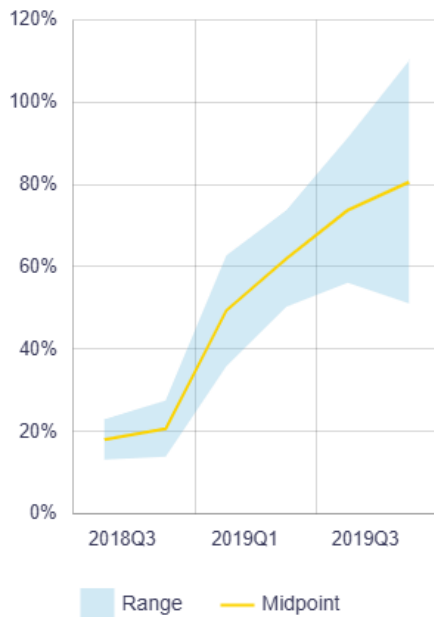
Synthetic control price estimates, all tariffed representative products; index: July 2017–June 2018 average = 1; vertical lines denote tariff period



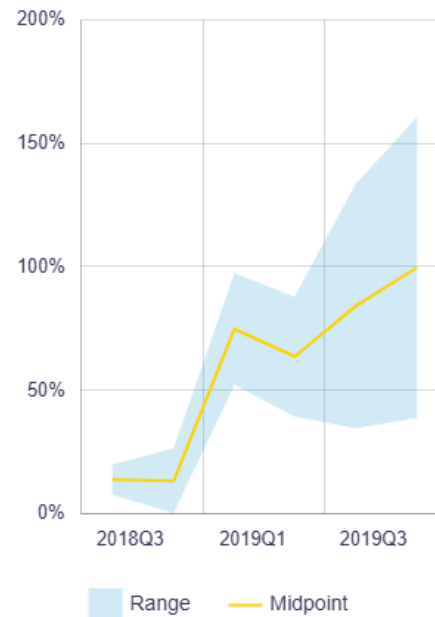

Range and midpoint estimates per quarter

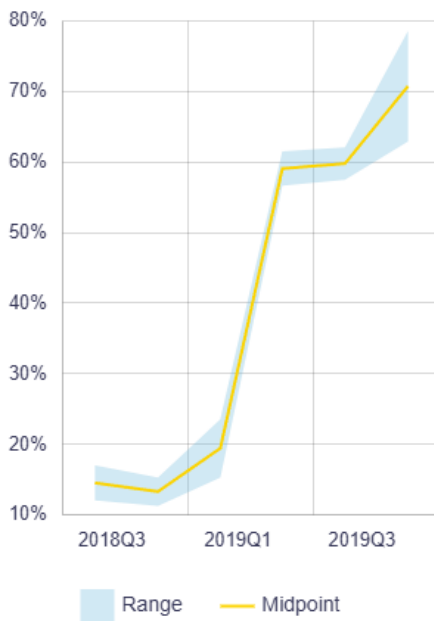
a. Total



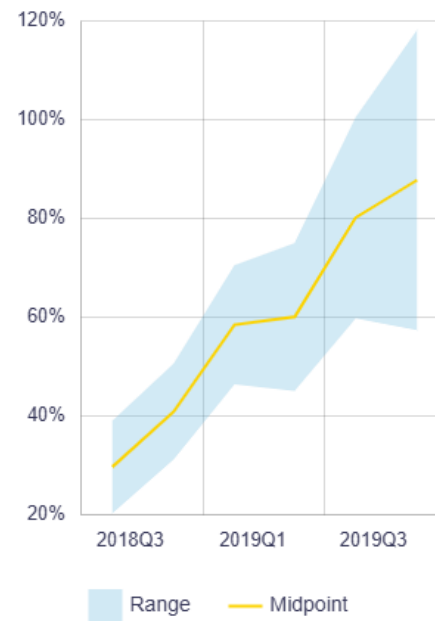
b. Food
