## **Key Takeaways**

- All candidates were considered **worthy of consideration** by participants in the groups. They also acknowledged that the **task ahead for the Bank was likely to be a difficult one**.
- Most thought the current process represented an opportunity to ensure the eventual portrait subject for the next \$5 bank note reflects and underscores our shared values, as well as our social and cultural make-up.
- There is recognition that 'accomplishments' or 'merit' should be considered first and foremost when selecting the portrait subject for the \$5 bank note. However, diversity and gender need to be considered.
- There is appeal in the next candidate being of **Indigenous heritage**. For many participants, this is an **opportunity to further Reconciliation efforts** and highlight the importance of our Indigenous population as part of our social and cultural fabric.
